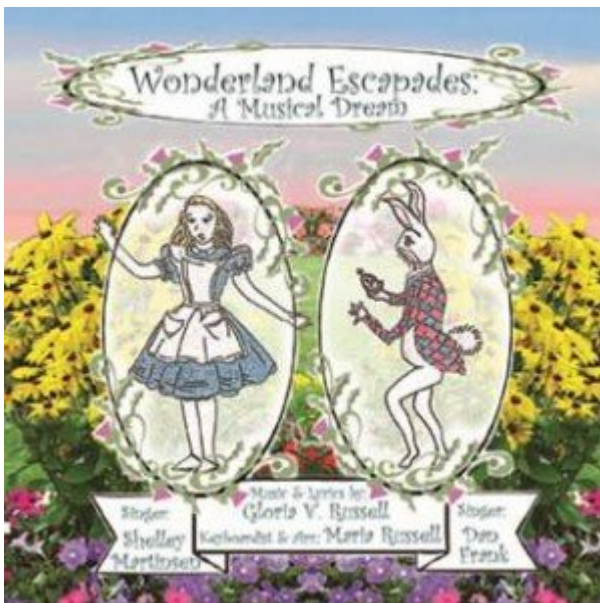

MARIA RUSSELL’s Imaginative Musical Tale ‘Wonderland Escapes: A Musical Dream’
(2010-04-09 18:20) - Losillë



Helping Bring To Life Songs Her Mother Gloria Penned During Maria's Childhood, The Las Vegas Based Pianist/Arranger Creates A Delightful, Stylistically Diverse Album Based On Alice's Adventures As Originally Conceived by Lewis Carroll

One of the most popular, charming and imaginative tales ever told, "Alice In Wonderland" —originally published as "Alice's Adventures in Wonderland" by Lewis Carroll in 1865—is a worldwide pop culture phenomenon once again thanks to Disney's new film mixing live action and animation, directed by Tim Burton and starring Johnny Depp.

Considering the clamoring for all things Alice, there could never be a better time for Las Vegas based pianist and arranger [1]Maria Russell to release *Wonderland Escapades: A Musical Dream*—a beautifully conceived and crafted CD of songs composed by her mother Gloria V. Russell that were inspired by scenes, characters and set pieces from the well known children's story.

Broken into three acts with several scenes and songs each, *Wonderland Escapades* features Maria's arrangements and piano and keyboard performances, as well as guest vocals by Shelley Martinsen and Dan Frank, singers for the Vegas based Nevada Opera Theatre. Among the many musical endeavors around the city that Maria takes part in, she has been the featured pianist with this theatre for the past eight years.

While the movie's success makes the timing of the stylistically diverse CD intriguing, this is actually a labor of love begun by Gloria many years ago, when the Russell family lived in Fort Walton Beach on the Florida Panhandle. Gloria originally composed the opening song "Dream Child" as a lullaby for Maria when she was a baby, and wrote the other songs some years later when her daughter was taking ballet lessons. Gloria's goal was to compose a new version of "Alice in Wonderland" as a ballet for the Fort Walton Beach Ballet Company.

Because she lacked a formal background in music, she sang the songs on cassette tapes which she then had transcribed to sheet music by a friend named Francis Garziglia. He passed away before he could finish transcribing, and this budding treasure trove of 20 songs (the current project has 13 tracks plus a reprise of the high energy "Wacky Hot Wheels") languished for many years—during which time Maria grew up, attended the University of Nevada, Las Vegas and began carving a multi-faceted musical career in the city.

"About five years ago, my mom and I started talking about these songs and thought they might make a very good family and children's recording project," says Maria. "We started reviving some of the songs and made them more upbeat and contemporary. While they were originally conceived for a ballet, we realized they would work even better as part of a musical theatre production. Because my degree was in piano performance, I knew I could create great arrangements and also finish some of the songs that hadn't been completed. Our idea was to bring the project up to date, and because Shelley and Dan also do a lot of character acting and singing, I knew they would be perfect for the vocals."

"We have ambitions now to turn *Wonderland Escapades* into a musical, and have written a script for it" she adds, "but mom's first goal was to put the songs on a CD. To give them context, we wrote a bit of a storyline that listeners can follow in the liner notes. We break everything into acts, scenes and characters so everyone can follow along as they enjoy the music. We did the recording in a studio at UNLV and were so excited to hear the songs come to life after so many years. I grew up enjoying the original book 'Alice's Adventures in Wonderland' and the original animated Disney film, and now fully appreciate why it is so timeless."

One of the remarkable aspects of *Wonderland Escapades* is Maria's brilliant and eclectic arrange-

ments, which make each song stand alone as a unique entity representing a different character or setting in Wonderland. “Dream Child” (about when Alice begins falling asleep), “Wonderland Dream,” “Waltz of the Roses” and “Magic Ballet” are classically influenced, while “Wacky Hot Wheels” is an irresistibly funky instrumental synth and piano romp. The pianist weaves a percussive tango into “The Fan Tango” and gets frisky on the vocal tune “The White Rabbit Dance,” which captures the scene where the white rabbit runs across the field and into the rabbit hole. “Pup and Purr” sets the tone after Alice enters the enchanted forest and runs into a big pup chasing what turns out to be the Cheshire Cat (who introduces himself via the jazz and blues influenced “Cheshire Cat Blues”).

Other tracks include “The Dee Dum Dee Song” (which finds Alice running into two brothers fighting over a rattle), “The Jub Jub Jig” (which refers to the funny dance done by the dragonlike Jabberwocky), “Teattle Tottle Dance” (after the Mad Hatter invites Alice to his tea party) and “Wondrous Parade,” which functions on the CD (and, one day, will on stage) as the curtain call.

Wonderland Escapades is available for purchase on [2]CDBaby.com and as a digital download on iTunes.

When Gloria began composing these songs during Maria’s childhood, she could scarcely have imagined the accomplished musical force her daughter would one day become. A professional pianist since the age of eleven, Maria received the Devos Music Scholarship from the University of Nevada, Las Vegas—where she graduated Magna Cum Laude with a Bachelor’s of Music in Piano Performance and a Bachelor’s and Master’s of Computer Science.

Maria’s musical background includes performances at various Las Vegas casino/hotels and restaurants, including the Forum Shops at Caesars Palace and most recently the Ritz-Carlton at Lake Las Vegas. Serving as the musical director and keyboardist for the City of Las Vegas Melodramas in the Park, she arranged scores to fit the action and drama of the plays.

As pianist for the Nevada Opera Theatre for the last eight years, she has performed on piano and keyboards with the orchestra for the production of “Gigi” and many others. Maria has also produced five previous CDs and currently plays at two Las Vegas churches (The Shrine of the Most Holy Redeemer and Holy Family Church) and the Ritz Carlton, Lake Las Vegas. Tate Music Group is in the process of producing the second edition of her Soaring With Angels CD, due in mid-2010. She is also a freelance graphic artist and website designer.

“I really loved all aspects of the experience of arranging and recording Wonderland Escapades,” she says. “It was fun talking with mom about what she originally envisioned for these songs and trying to figure out ways to make them true to that intent while also becoming part of a viable commercial project. It’s exciting to take this project to the next level and now we’re all geared up to put the pieces together to make it a full-fledged musical.”

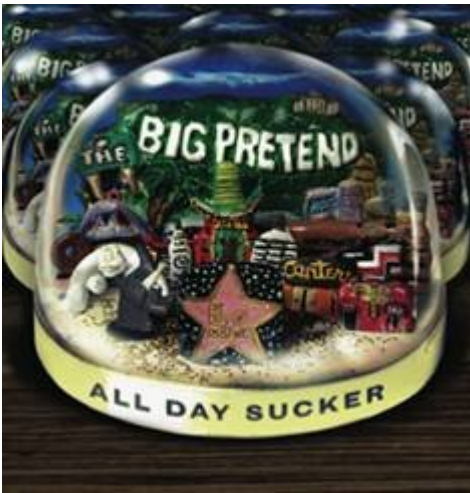

SHAMAN'S HARVEST: Missouri Rockers Release Rising Single, 'Dragonfly' Off Their Album 'Shine' & Tour This Spring Performing At Rockfest, Rock On The Range and Rocklahoma (2010-04-11 20:19) - Losillë



Having Opened For Everyone From Alice In Chains and AC/DC to Papa Roach and Godsmack, The Five Piece Band Is Gearing Up For Rockfest in Kansas City (May 15), Rock On The Range In Columbus, Ohio (May 22-23) And Rocklahoma On Memorial Day Weekend

A little wiki research into the symbolism of the “[1]Dragonfly” perfectly explains why Missouri based rock powerhouse [2]Shaman’s Harvest is scoring across the board success with the explosive first single from their new album [3]Shine.

On Mediabase, which tracks national radio airplay, the song has been in the Top 20 on two charts—Active Rock and Mainstream Rock. “Dragonfly” has also been buzzing on numerous Billboard charts, spending over six weeks on the Rock Songs chart and also placing on the Active Rock chart and Heritage Rock chart.

While the song has scanned an incredible nearly 30,000 singles on iTunes, it’s also lit up phone request lines on stations everywhere from Springfield, Missouri and Omaha to Boise, Spokane, Flint, Michigan and Waterloo, Iowa, placing in the Top 5 of all requests. It’s also spinning in Salt Lake City, Detroit, Atlanta and Portland, Oregon, with more outlets still being added weekly—an incredible achievement considering that it’s happening based purely on buzz for a DIY effort, without any sort of major label promotion, distribution or affiliation!

Even before the band got around to shooting a video for “Dragonfly” late last year, the word of mouth on the song was so great that a fan generated YouTube video (with just an image of a dragonfly accompanying the song) became a massive hit; it’s currently up to almost 300,000 views. The official band video is currently running on two YouTube channels and has amassed over 150,000 views.

While the meaning of a dragonfly changes with each culture, they always represent renewal, positive force and the power of life in general. The multi-talented, Jefferson City based five piece band affirms this with every performance, whether they’re jamming at their home base the Blue Note in Columbia, Missouri or opening for superstars Alice In Chains and AC/DC.

Thousands of the group’s fans will be flocking in late May to see them perform at three major festivals: Rockfest in Kansas City (May 15), Rock on the Range in Columbus, Ohio (May 22-23) and Rocklahoma on Memorial Day weekend. Shaman’s Harvest will be playing alongside headliners like Papa Roach, Drowning Pool, Seether, Three Days Grace, Godsmack, Rob Zombie, Limp Bizkit, Slash, Deftones, ZZ Top, and Buckcherry.

World Wrestling Entertainment (WWE) recently contacted Shaman’s Harvest about recording a song written by their staff writer Jim Johnston for wrestler Drew McIntyre’s 2010 entrance theme. “Broken Dreams” is currently being aired nationally and has resulted in over a combined 200,000 YouTube plays.

Dragonflies can also be a symbol of the sense of self that comes with maturity, which Shaman’s Harvest has brilliantly achieved as songwriters, artists and performers in the years since core members, front man Nathan “Drake” Hunt, bassist Matt Fisher and rhythm guitarist Josh Hamler first began jamming in high school. Last year’s addition of lead guitarist Ryan Tomlinson and longtime drummer Craig Wingate combined with the founding trio to create the perfect chemistry.

SH loyalists have long responded to the powerful melodies, rich harmonies and deep percussion textures that cut to the heart of what the band is all about. According to Drake and Josh, the band’s moniker touches on the ethereal aspects of the music and its unique power to soothe and heal, while also tapping into the primal aspects of music when, as Drake says it, “people were beating on drums and moving around a fire.”

Josh adds: “People are always asking us what the name Shaman’s Harvest means, so we like to say it’s the shaman spirit that brought us together and music is the harvest that we have created and reaped from that. Music makes us move, it’s a vent for pain and anger and an expression of all these basic primal emotions. We love performing live because our songs translate really well and the audience knows the difference between when we’re on our game and when we’re just sort of showing up. So that keeps us

motivated to always be on top of things.”

“I love the fact that onstage, we never feel our songs have to be exactly the same as on the record,” Josh adds. “After playing the song for a while, we start rocking out and jamming a little bit, doing what we love to do. So fans that come to see us live should never expect us to do the songs from Shine or the bands other albums verbatim. A lot of artists just duplicate the recordings night after night, but we think by making every show unique the audience appreciates what we do more.”



MISSOURI BASED ROCK POWERHOUSE REAPS SUCCESS WITH “DRAGONFLY,” THE SINGLE FROM THEIR LATEST ALBUM SHINE THAT’S CHARTING ON MEDIABASE AND HAS SPENT WEEKS ON THREE BILLBOARD ROCK CHARTS

Drake and Josh explain that there’s also a deep meaning behind the album title Shine. Drake says, “The band had been around a few years with various lineups and we were determined that this was the last album we were going to do if we didn’t achieve some form of national success. So it was our time to ‘Shine,’ and we’re all excited that there will be many more albums to come! The song is actually a burst of confidence, like ‘this is our moment and nothing is going to take us off this path.’”

The band’s original plan was to follow-up their CD [4]March of the Bastards by recording just “Dragonfly” and “Last Goodbye,” a compelling power ballad. These demos turned out so good that they decided to write and record more songs until they had what Josh calls “a solid batch of eight demos” that became Shine. The set also features fan favorites “Turn It Up” and “Strike the Slate.”

“Because we did things this way,” he says, “there was a sense of spontaneity, doing something unexpected that we really enjoyed, rather than writing and recording songs we had to write on a timetable. That spirit translated well to the music on the album, and we’re really excited that the success of ‘Dragonfly’ around the country has allowed us to play for several hundred people when in the past we were lucky if 25 to 50 fans showed up. It’s definitely more fun to feed off the energy of a large crowd that’s going wild, and we’re excited to get out there and do more of that this year!”

I wasn't sure it would be worth my time to go to a show. I checked them out on MySpace. Boy was I wrong! I double checked to make sure I had the correct profile. The demos on their profile were wonderful. Their CD "This House Has Been Condemned" drops in May and will be released on vinyl, digitally and on a CD that will be included with the vinyl purchase. Ape Machine is Caleb Heinze – Vocals, Ian Watts – Guitar, Jimi Miller – Guitar, Brian True – Bass, Damon Delapaz – Drums. If you have read my best-selling "how to" book for aspiring band sluts, [1]Always Fuck The Drummer you know how

important I think it is for a band to have a good drummer. Damon Delapaz gets my vote. To say drummer Delapaz kicks ass is an understatement, his technique is mesmerizing. He has a style that appears to be relentless abandonment of the rules while maintaining total control of the sticks. I don't have the vocabulary to adequately describe how enjoyable it is to watch him play. There are times when a drummer like Delapaz will chew up the wall paper and completely overwhelm the other band members. Not here, Ape Machine is so tight that he complements rather than overwhelms. Each band member brings the same excellent level of talent and professionalism to the stage. The band's name is interesting and unique. (There aren't 35 pages of bands with the same name when you go to MySpace.) Watts said he had a tape deck in his recording studio that had lost the "t" in tape. The resulting sticker was ape machine. This reference became the name of the band. My interview was short and missing my most in depth questions. We were outside in a cold wind and they were hot and sweaty. Don't get me wrong, I love hot sweaty men I was just worried they would get a chill. Next time I will delve into the more important aspects of their music with questions like,



“Do any of you sleep in the nude?”

Ape Machine Caleb Heinze – Vocals Like all good things the show came to an end with the last song of the night. It was blues sexy. Voice and music and men, Oh My! Heinze delivered “Blues in E Flat – Never Go Home” in a way that can only be described as “take your clothes off and throw yourself on the stage”. My recommendations: 1. Go to our photo [2]gallery for pics from that night. 2. Listen to them on [3]MySpace. 3. Catch a show, Ape Machine tours down to San Diego and back every two months. 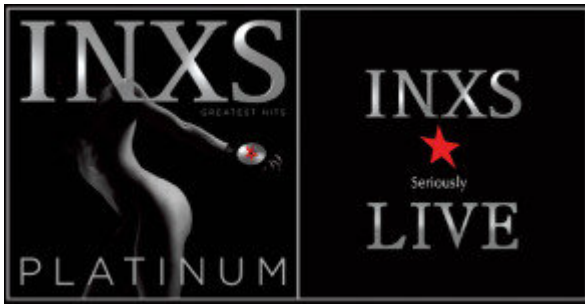

Fortune years, leaving off recent hits like Pretty Vegas and Afterglow that received loads of airplay during the Rockstar: INXS TV show where the band picked their latest (perhaps former?) lead singer, J.D. Fortune of Canada. Quite an odd move to leave off your most recent hits even though the credits close with a dedication to their late frontman, Michael Hutchence who passed away in 1997.

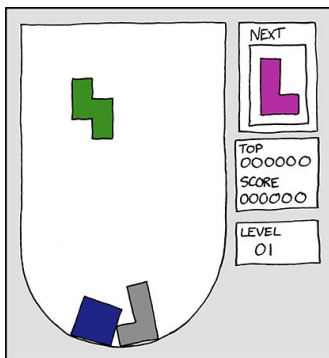

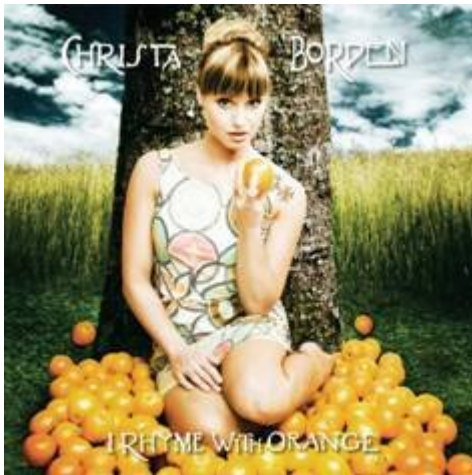

Last week saw the Finnish band [1]HIM, consisting of vocalist Ville Valo, lead guitarist Linde Lindström, bassist Migé Paananen, drummer Gas Karppinen and keyboardist Burton Puurtinen, perform a trio of sold out shows across southern California culminating with a fiery sold out set at the historic Los Angeles Wiltern Theatre.

It's been nearly three years since HIM has toured America with their heavy melodic rock that draws in music lovers of all ages. The set included new tracks such as "Like St. Valentine" and "Heartkiller" which translated well live and instantly became audience sing along favorites with classics like "Funeral of Hearts" and "Rip Out the Wings of a Butterfly". Valo's vocals are strong and his interaction with the audience is greatly improved in his new sober state. HIM fans rarely need encouragement to sing along with the band, a feat not easily achieved by some artists. Guitarist Linde Lindström provided searing guitar licks while concentrating so hard on his craft he often seems to hardly notice the audience is there. He quietly steals the spotlight with his incredible live performance.

Openers included [3]Drive A, a young punk group that reminds us of Green Day when they just started out. They had some great energy during their brief set.

Up next was [4]Dommin who put on more of a gloomy, romantic set. This band clearly has a good following underway and some catchy tunes. However, the bassist has a weird, distracting stance when playing, almost like a kid that doesn't know how to adjust the strap on his bass to fit his body and some of the gloomy intros were fairly repetitive on each song. The keyboard player provided some different & catchy organ like solos during the set. I'd definitely like to hear more from this band though.

Up just before HIM were [5]We Are The Fallen comprised of former members of Evanescence and American Idol contestant Carly Smithson. Smithson has a nice voice and the potential to grow into a really good performer. Overall, the band were just too loud for her vocals and they need to find their own footing outside of Evanescence. Their debut album is out May 11th and details can be found on their website.

HIM band members Linde Lindström and Burton Puurtinen have just released their latest solo project as [6]Daniel Lioneye available now via the [7]Omega Order. HIM continues their tour of America through May 9th in [8]NYC before heading home to Europe to play the summer festivals. Be sure to catch them this summer!
